Once we have all the clients on board the transport, and **during the initial presentation** which is done, we must ALWAYS **introduce the protocol of health and safety related to COVID-19** before carrying on with the work and duties we have been assigned.

<u>Remember</u>

YOU DON'T GET A SECOND CHANCE TO MAKE A GOOD FIRST IMPRESSION

IMPORTANT

- Those acreditations, qualifications, certificates and/or badges which acredit training received should always be visible, generating a sense of security for the customer. (N)
- Inform, always transmitting a sense of security, tranquillity and confidence in the measures contained in the protocol applied. (N)
 - 1. The usual short introduction (names of the team etc.).
 - Presentation of the "PSS" which should always include the following information, to be shared at the start with all tourists on board:

Information for users on the Health & Safety Protocol

- Respect the safe distance between the guide, professionals involved and users. If this is not possible, the use of PPE is mandatory for everyone inside the transport. (N)
- Ensure that all members of the group use the hydroalcoholic gel not only before boarding the transport but also when entering and leaving toilets, boat, bus and during any other visits to a site of interest or other establishment. (N)
- Make sure that the members of the group do not change seats, and respect safe distancing throughout the activity. (R)
- Families and/or people who cohabit can be at less than 1,5 metros from each other and travel together in the transport. (N)
- Organise y explain the rules regarding entering and exiting the transport and the correct use of doors/stairs/ramps in relation to the occupied seats. (N)
- Urge the passengers to download the information available by QR code to their own mobile.
 (N)
- In boats and/or other means of transport which have two aisles or more, EXPLAIN that one-way routes are established to avoid crossing paths with other passengers. (N)
